WHEREAS

The Parties hereto, recognizing the benefits of establishing international links, wish to strengthen the ties between their respective institutions by entering into this Memorandum of Understanding (MoU).

NOW IT IS HEREBY AGREED

- The purpose of this MoU is to develop co-operation and promote mutual understanding and excellence in practice-based education, research and knowledge exchange between the Parties. Both agree to strengthen ties of friendship and to promote Cultural, Educational and Scientific Cooperation.
- 2. In furtherance of this purpose the Parties agree to develop the following activities in collaboration in areas of mutual academic interest:
 - 2.1 Exchanges of academic and administrative staff and mutual visits to pursue research and to lecture.

- 2.5 Exchanges of academic information and materials.
- 2.6 Promoting collaboration in fields of mutual interest.
- 2.7 Promoting other academic co-operation and collaboration as mutually agreed.
- The Parties hereby agree that the development and implementation of specific activities developed under this MoU will be the subject of formal 3. written agreements negotiated and entered into separately, which will deal with the financial arrangements, confidentiality, ownership and use of intellectual property, publication of articles or other work and other relevant matters and shall depend upon the availability of resources and financial support of the Parties concerned.
- Parties acknowledge the need to promote the programme and activities and hereby agree to use promotional materials that have been approved by the 5. other Party.
- Both Parties agree that staff and students of either institution engaged in any activities shall carry out these activities in accordance with the laws and 6. regulations of their respective countries after full consultation and approval.

The termination of this MoU shall not affect the implementation of any specific activities established under a separate agreement prior to such termination.
- 10. Nothing in this MoU shall be construed as creating any legal relationships between the Parties.

f) In order to achieve the afore mentioned objectives, both parties, in mutual 2. METHODFOR ACHIEVINGTHE OBJECT®VES: agreement, shall develop cooperation programs and projects that will specify the commitments each of them is to make for the performance of said programs.

3. AREAS OF CO-OPERATION:

- g) Whereas, ST. XAVIER'S COLLEGE and HOLY CROSS HOME SCIENCE COLLEGE, THOOTHUKUDI, recognize that the academic collaboration would be of mutual benefit and would provide strength since search and education and their mutual interest in engaging themselves in academic cooperation. As per the purpose of the saidagreement, the two parties shall:
 - a. Research Collaborations: Faculty / Researchers / Students of ST. XAVIER'S COLLEGE and HOLY CROSS HOME SCIENCE COLLEGE, THOOTHUKUDI, can collaborate in future research projects that either involve working cooperatively with partner institutions and / or cover a research topic with an international component. Activities include, but are not limited to, efforts toward developing proposals for collaborative research, co-authoring publication, conducting joint research projects, or establishing joint research centersetc.
 - members Faculty Institutions: Partner with Exchange Faculty b. ST. XAVIER'S COLLEGE and HOLY CROSS HOME SCIENCE COLLEGE, THOOTHUKUDI, can travel between to participate in activities that can enhancetheir international / national experience and knowledge and also to fosterrelations between the parties. Activities include, but are not limited to, delivering lectures, teaching a course, taking a sabbatical, acquiring skills for institutional governance and developing collaborative research etc.
- Student Exchange with Partner Institutions: Students can be given an c. opportunity to travel among parties to participate in activities / events that will enhance their international /inte cultural experience and knowledge.

- d. Promotion of integrated studies for related studies: The parties can look at integrating an international / intercultural dimension into their teaching, search, and service functions of the institution which would enable the students understanding on a global perspective.
- e. Cooperate in the exchange of information relating to their activities in teaching and research in fields of mutual interests; sharing best practices adopted by each parties; sharing of e-content between the parties; access to library and repository services, if possible.
- f. Conduct cultural projects, study tours, as mutually agreed in writing between the parties prior to commencement of this activity.

4. FUNDING:

- h) Expenses for air fare, transportation, room and board and personal expenses of exchange students, teachers or officers shall be covered by each individual. Students will pay their registration, courses or professional practices at their home institution, so that they can here cognized afterwards.
- i) Students, interns and officers shall be responsible for requesting and obtaining lodging by inquiring with the institution, which shall provide everyhelp necessary for them to obtain safe, convenient lodging arrangements.
- j) Financial expenses for (term visits) internships of professors and researchers, which will be arranged at the parties' request, as well as travel expenses, shall be covered by the requesting Institution. No fees will be paid, as the assumption is that the professors / researchers remain in their positions at their home institution, which will continue to pay their salaries.
- k) Students, professors and officers must acquire a medical insurance policy. The universities may offer them advice in seeking appropriate insurance.

5. NOEMPLOYMENTRELATIONSHIP:

1) The parties agree that this Agreement shall not be construed in any manner as establishing any kind of partnership or bond of a labor nature between them. Thus, in all activities stemming from the present MoU and from subsequent specific actionplans, the parties are in the understanding that, in all cases, employment relationships shall remain in force between the employing institution and its respective personnel

6. CREDITS / ACCREDITATION:

- m) Credits and grades shall be awarded in accordance with the academic achievement policies in force at the Institution / Host Institution / Government. However, the home institution / Institution reserves the right to accept or reject any accreditation leadingtoan academic degree.
- n) The Host Institution / Institution shall issue a certification recognizing the grades obtained, as well as the hours invested or projects / papers completed by the students.

7. RIGHTSANDDUTIES:

- o) The host institution / Institution is committed to counseling and supporting exchange students through advice on academic and administrative procedures, as well as to foster their integration, inviting and encouraging guest students to become involved in student life.
- p) The institutions shall act as facilitators, but they will have no obligation what so ever in terms of the actions, behaviors or financial aspects of the students / participants involved in the exchange.
- q) The students / participants shall enjoy the same rights and privileges as regular students / faculty, and shall observe the norms and rules of the Host Institution / Institution and in the host country. Any violation of the laws of the receiving country and / or the rules of the Host Institution / Institution by an exchange participants hall be grounds for the immediate termination of the privileges in the context of this Agreement.
- r) The host institution agrees to assist to provide boarding, lodging and necessities and to provide work space, library and laboratory facilities as appropriate.

8. AUTONOMY:

s) This agreement is a statement of intentions and does not involve, in any instance whatsoever, any financial obligations between the subscribing institutions.

9. TERM:

- t) This MOU shall be effective for a period of five (5) years from the date of execution of this agreement, and shall be automatically renewed there after for another five (5) years unless a written notice to terminate or amend this agreement is given to the other party six(6)months in advance.
- u) It is expressly agreed that neither party shall be liable for damages that they mightcause each other as a result of a forceful suspension of a collaboration


₁₀. CONFLICTRESOLUTION:

Any dispute resulting from the interpretation or application of this Agreement shall be settled through direct negotiation and **common agreement** by the persons delegated to such end by each institution. Either party may propose to the other a modification of the Agreement at anytime in writing.

 - b. Objective of the action plan for inter-institutional collaboration;
 - c. General conditions of the plan;
 - d. Academic conditions of the plan;
 - e. Administrative and organizational conditions of the plan;
 - f. Duration of the protocol;
 - g. Intellectual property;
 - h. Differences between the parties;
 - Development of the collaboration project;
 - j. Project and / or program to be carriedout;
 - k. Financial budget;
 - 1. Reference to the subject of medical insurance and information.
