Holy Cross Home Science College, established in 1975, is administered by the Society of the Sisters of the Cross of Chavanod, Madurai Province. The College is affiliated to Manonmaniam Sundaranar University, Tirunelveli. It was Re-accredited with 'B' grade by NAAC. We pay homage to our Foundress Claudine Echenier, who founded the Congregation of the Sisters of the Cross of Chavanod, in France, in the year 1838 and I remember our pioneering Sisters of this college who had the vision to create this institution a place of learning and women's emancipation.

Empowered by the self-emptying love of God and inspired by our Mother Foundress, we, the Sisters of the Cross envision a just and harmonious society where all people live life in its fullness. Our mission is to nurture persons to be well integrated who in turn become agents of societal change and our goal is to form persons of character, conscience, compassion,

commitment and competence.

The college aims at the all round formation of students to achieve wholeness and all our programmes are equipped to achieve this goal.

The tireless energy offered by our faculty members in bringing about significant improvements and initiatives in higher education especially to our institution, served as an inspiration for our students and parents. On behalf of the entire Crossian fraternity, I extend a hearty welcome and express my gratitude to staff council members for accepting to listen to the report. There are many milestones we have achieved. I take this opportunity to thank my colleagues of various departments for their whole-hearted support, cooperation and trust in all the endeavours. Courses at our College:

- The College runs 6 UG, and 3 PG courses, one Research Centre for Commerce; Certificate Course under the Career Oriented Programme (COP); and 18 Vocational Training Programmes.

Admissions 2020-2021:

- Admissions 2020-21 went off smoothly. The total number of applications received for both UG and PG courses was 879 and the total admitted was 313.
- I profusely thank the Vice Principal, Heads of Departments, teaching faculty and administrative staff, as well as students for their whole-hearted participation in the admission process.

The new academic year 2020-2021 began on 1st August 2020.

Our Strength:

- We now have a total strength of 42 teaching staff, 12 supportive staff and 632 students (UG: 558, PG: 74).
- Seventeen members of the teaching staff are Ph.D Holders and five faculty members are on the process of completion.
- 11 staff members have cleared SET/ NET examination.

Students Induction Programme:

Academic Progression:

In the academic year 2020-2021, 179 students passed out and 55 students are pursuing their higher studies and 20 students are placed in various organizations.

LISA:

Library with open access system holds 6059 books and subscribes 26 journals (06 International and 20 National) and 12 periodicals. This year 137 books have been added to the existing collection. The amount spent for books and journals in 2020-2021 is Rs.64,918. The library is linked with Inflibnet N-List facility. At the beginning of the academic year, the librarian organizes Orientation Programme for the freshers about the use of library resources. Library automation was done with bar coding for the books and for the students’ entry.

Sports:

- The importance of sports and games encompasses more than just the benefit of physical activity. It increases self-esteem, mental alertness and teaches the students’ life skills like teamwork, leadership and patience. Our students participated in Kabadi organized by Manonmaniam Sundaranar University in Intercollegiate Competition which was held at Government Arts and Science College, Srivaikundam on 04th September 2019.
