










5.Frequency of discussion on the performance of assignment submitted






7.Opinion on the cognitive, social and emotional growth of the students provided by the teaching and mentoring process of the institution ⁵⁹ responses




8. Agreeability of multiple opportunities provided by the institution to learn and grow.





9.Frequency of giving information about expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes to the students by the teachers 60 responses






10.Frequency of follow-up by the Mentor 60 responses






11. Frequency of illustrating the concepts through examples and applications by the teachers $_{\rm 60\ responses}$




12. Opinion on the identification of strengths by the teachers and encouragement by providing the right level of challenges.






18. Teaching using ICT tools such as LCD projector, Multimedia, etc. (in percentage) 60 responses
